## FORMAT

Scramble Play – 36 holes. Lowest team net score for 36 holes will be champion. A tie for first place will be a sudden death playoff until the winners are determined. The event is played with 20% of the lowest handicap player, 15% of the second lowest handicap player, 10% of the third lowest handicap player and 5% of the highest handicap player.

## PLAYER REGISTRATION

All contestants must register prior to their first round shotgun start. Registration will be available during the following hours:

## PRACTICE AREAS

The practice range will open one hour prior to the starting time each day of competition.

## DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Shirts must have a collar or sleeves. Shorts may be worn, but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. **The following items are forbid: short-shorts, tank tops, cut-off shorts, jogging shorts, and gym shorts. Absolutely no metal spikes.**
