PRACTICE ROUNDS

If desired, you may contact Fremont Golf Club at (402) 721-6641 to arrange a practice round, Green fees are \$40 and includes cart.

FORMAT

Stroke Play – 54 holes. Lowest score for 54 holes will be crowned champion. If any players are tied for the Championship only, a sudden death playoff will occur.

In the event of ties for all other flights or positions within a flight, the combined prize monies will be divided, pro rata.

The first 36 holes will also include a partner (net) Eclectic event. The eclectic event will be two competitors playing as partners, each playing her own ball receiving 75% of her course handicap. For the first 18-holes, the lower net score of the partners is the team score for that hole. During the second day of competition they can better their score on a hole-by-hole basis to determine an 18-hole overall score for the event. A player may elect to play in both events or just the Senior Stroke Play event. Rounds 1 and 2 will be qualifying for individual flight position for Round 3 play.

Day-by-Day breakdown:

Day 1 - 18-holes, stroke-play, with partner for eclectic event. Teams will be paired in groups of four, with their partner, based on the total combined partner's handicaps. If two teams have identical handicaps, the individual with the lower handicap will receive a lower pairing position.

Day 2 - 18-holes, stroke-play, with partner for eclectic event. Teams will be paired in groups of four, with their partner, based on the team's first day net score. The Medalist will be the participant with the lowest 36-hole round. For the Eclectic Event, there will be one flight made up of the full field and the top 1/3 of the field will receive prizes. Flights will be composed after the second round of competition. If necessary, one or more participants at the bottom of one flight may be paired with participants in the next flight.

Day 3- 18-holes, stroke play. Individuals will be paired together based on their two-day total gross score. With the exception to the overall Champion, in the event of ties within flights, the prize monies will be combined and divided pro-rata.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All contestants must register prior to their first round starting time. Registration will be available during the following hours:

Monday, August 7th, 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

PRACTICE AREAS

The practice range will open two hours prior to the starting time on the first day and one hour prior on days two and three. Complimentary range balls will be available on the driving range for competitors use.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Shirts must have a collar or sleeves. Shorts may be worn, but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. **The following items are forbid: short-shorts, tank tops, cut-off shorts, jogging shorts, and gym shorts.** Absolutely no metal spikes.

CADDIES and CARTS

The cost of automotive transportation (cart) is included in the tournament entry fee. If you prefer to walk you may carry your own bag, use a pull cart, or provide your own caddie. Caddies represent the player and any conduct of the caddie will reflect on the competitor.

STARTING TIMES

Groupings and starting times for the first round (Monday, August 7th) are available by visiting the tournament website or by clicking the link below. Second and third round play will be a shotgun beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 8th and Wednesday, August 9th.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE – PLAYERS LUNCHEON BUFFET

A complimentary dinner will be held Monday, August 7th following play and an awards luncheon will follow play on Wednesday, August 9th. The clubhouse will be available for any other food and beverage purchases throughout the competition.
