**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Championships)

**Abnormal Ground Conditions:**

Newly Planted Trees identified by a ribbon, wire flag and/or black tubing are deemed to be ground under repair from which relief must be taken for interference of the lie of ball, stance, or area of intended swing.

Prepared Flower and Plant Beds (including their rock borders) are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines.

**Integral Part of the Course:**

Railroad ties located within the margins of Water Hazards are deemed to be an Integral Part of the Course, therefore, no relief without penalty.

**Obstructions:**

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel, asphalt or mulch.

Bunker liners are immovable obstructions.

Yardage Posts are movable obstructions; the ground level base is an immovable obstruction.

Prepared Flower and Plant Beds adjacent to immovable obstructions have the same status, that of immovable obstructions.

White Stakes defining Out of Bounds along the right side of hole #8 are immovable obstructions during play of hole #7.

**Out of Bounds:**

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and white lines.

**Deciding Ties:**

In the case of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each flight, ties will be broken and the winner determined as follows:

- By the results of their head to head match.
- Highest point total on Day 1 (Race 1,2, and 3 combined).
- Highest point total on Day 2 (Race 4 and 5 combined).
- Most points in Race 1.
- Most points in Race 2.
- Most points in Race 3.
- Most points in Race 4.
- Most points in Race 5.
- If still tied, the winner will be decided by lot.

**Teeing Ground:**

Blue tee-markers define the teeing ground for the Bobbie Hopp Challenge.

**Water Hazards:**

The Water Hazard near the teeing ground on hole #17 is played as a Lateral Water Hazard during hole #11.
