NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Championships & Events)

Teeing Ground:

The Black Tee-Markers define the teeing ground for the championship flight.

The Silver Tee-Markers define the teeing ground for the non-championship players.

Deciding Ties:

In case of a tie for first place in the Championship Flight only, concerned players shall immediately play-off hole-by-hole to determine the winner. Play shall commence at the 1st tee, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

Integral Part of the Course:

Blue Paint Dots - Used to define the depth on each putting green and deemed to be an integral part of the course, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, concrete, gravel or asphalt. Rule 24-2.

Skulls used as Distance Markers are deemed to be movable obstructions. Rule 24-1.

Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green - Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. If the player's ball lies on the putting green and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green intervenes on his line of putt, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and placed at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

Exception: A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if interference by anything other than the immovable obstruction makes the stroke clearly impracticable.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and white lines.

Roads and Paths:

Concrete and artificially surfaced roads and paths are obstructions. *Worn or sandy paths or roads that are not artificially surfaced are through the green and free relief is not available.*

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – The scoring area is defined by the area underneath the scoring tent.

Temporary Immovable Obstruction:

Tents are temporary immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken on either side of these TIO's as described in Appendix I.
