## **FORMAT**

The Four-Ball Tournament consists of 36-holes of gross and net four-ball stroke play. Teams consist of two partners. Each team member will receive 95% of their course handicap. Lowest net score for 36-holes will be tournament champion. A tie for first place will be played off until a winner is determined. If the event of a tie for the gross team champion, duplicate awards will be presented.

**Day 1** - 18-holes, four-ball stroke play. Teams will be paired based upon total course handicap of each team. When possible, teams from the same club will not be paired together.

**Day 2** - 18-holes, four-ball stroke play. For the second round of competition, teams will be paired by the team's cumulative net best-ball score. There will be one flight made up of the full field and the top 1/3 of the field will receive prizes. With the exception of overall team champion, ties will be combined and divided, pro-rata.

## **PLAYER REGISTRATION**

Players are required to register between 10:30 a.m. and 12 p.m. on Monday, August 20.

## **PRACTICE AREAS**

Practice areas will be available to contestants at 10:30 a.m. prior to play Monday and at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday; complimentary practice balls will be available on the range.

## **DRESS CODE**

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Shirts must have a collar or sleeves. Shorts may be worn, but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. The following items are forbidden: short-shorts, tank tops, cut-off shorts, jogging shorts and gym shorts. Absolutely no metal spikes.

## **CADDIES and CARTS**

The cost of automotive transportation (cart) was included in the tournament entry fee. If you prefer to walk you may carry your own bag, use a pull cart, or provide your own caddie. Caddies represent the player and any conduct of the caddie will reflect on the competitor.

### **GROUPINGS AND STARTING TIMES**

Groupings and starting times for the first round (Monday, August 20) will be available by visiting the tournament website or by clicking the link below. Second round play will be a shotgun beginning at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, August 21 with groups determined based on round one cumulative net best-ball score.
