NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Championships & Events)

Teeing Ground:

The Blue Tee-Markers define the teeing ground for the Tournament.

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Newly Planted Trees identified by a ribbon, wire flag and/or black tubing are deemed to be ground under repair from which relief must be taken for interference of the lie of ball, stance, or area of intended swing.

Prepared Flower and Plant Beds (including their rock borders) are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines.

Drop Zones:

Hole #13 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard (yellow), the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ” located in the fairway.

Hole #14 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the lateral water hazard (red) along the left, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ” located in the left rough.

Hole #15 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard (yellow), the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ”.

Deciding Ties:

In case of a tie for first place in the net competition only, concerned teams shall immediately play-off hole-by-hole to determine the winner. Play shall commence at the 10th tee, unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

Integral Part of the Course:

Railroad ties located within the margins of Water Hazards are deemed to be an Integral Part of the Course, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel, asphalt or mulch.

Bunker liners are immovable obstructions.

Yardage Posts are movable obstructions; the ground level base is an immovable obstruction.

Prepared Flower and Plant Beds adjacent to immovable obstructions have the same status, that of immovable obstructions.

White Stakes defining Out of Bounds along the right side of hole #8 are immovable obstructions during play of hole #7.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and white lines.

Water Hazards:

The Water Hazard (yellow) along the right of hole #14 is treated as a Lateral Water Hazard during play of this hole.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – The scoring area is defined by the area underneath the deck.
