NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NGA Championships)

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Flower and Plant Beds are deemed to be Ground Under Repair even though not so defined by white lines.

Deciding Ties:

In the case of a tie for determining flights in the Non-Championship Division, a scorecard play-off will determine the flight you are placed in.

Drop Zones:

Hole #7 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the lateral water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ.”

Integral Part(s) of the Course:

Support walls associated with lateral water hazards are deemed to be integral parts of the course, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Obstructions within 2 club-lengths of the putting green. If a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard, and an immovable obstruction on or within two-club lengths of the putting green and within two-club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

Artificially-surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel, rocks or asphalt.

Landscaped areas encircled by cart paths are deemed to be part of the obstruction.

Liners in bunkers are obstructions.

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white lines and stakes. When both lines and stakes are present, the line defines Out of Bounds and the stakes identify.

Play-off:

Match Play – In the event of a match standing all square after 18-holes, play shall continue on the starting hole of the match unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring table.

Teeing Ground:

The NGA tee-markers define the teeing ground for the Championship Division.

The Red tee-markers define the teeing ground for the Non-Championship Division.
