FORMAT

Net Four-Ball Match Play with sides playing five 9-hole matches (called races) within a flight. Each flight is comprised of six two-person sides. Sides earn a point in each match for winning a hole and a half point for tying a hole. There are nine available points in each match however the maximum number of points a team can win in any match is 6, the minimum is 0. The side that accumulates the most points following the five matches wins their respective flight.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

If desired, please contact the Beatrice Country Club golf shop at (402) 223-2710 to arrange a practice round at an available time. The fee is \$25 for walking and \$43.00 including cart.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All teams must register Monday prior to their first Challenge match. Registration begins at 7:00 a.m. and will be located outside of the golf shop. **Players cannot arrive more than one hour prior to their tee time.**

GOLF CARTS

The fee for golf carts was included in the entry. Carts will be staged prior outside of the golf shop and around 18 green. The golf shop staff will assist in locating your respective golf cart. Cart signs will indicate whether you selected a single-rider cart or to share a cart with you partner, based on your registration form.

BEVERAGE SERVICE

Classic's Restaurant will be available for beverage service each day of the tournament.

MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

Due to COVID-19 concerns, each player will receive a boxed lunch on each day of play. Classic's Restaurant will be available for any post-round food or beverages.

LODGING

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice facilities will be open to tournament players beginning at 7:00 a.m. each day of the tournament. Player's must check-in before using practice facilities to ensure they are within the one-hour window prior to their tee time. Post-round practice is prohibited.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.

DIGITAL SCORING

Players will be required to use the USGA TM application (available on iOS and Android app store) which will serve as their Official Tournament Scorecard. Verification of scorecards will be done verbally following the round. Information on using the USGA TM application will be provided in advance with tutorials posted to the NWAGA web site.

HANDICAP ALLOWANCES

Based on June 22 Handicap Revision. An individual's Playing Handicap is 90% of their 9-Hole Course Handicap. Maximum Individual 9-Hole Handicap Index is 20.2. The 9-hole Playing Handicap of all four players in a match will be reduced by the 9-hole Playing Handicap of the player with the lowest Playing Handicap, who then plays from scratch. Example: Players A, B, C and D have a 9-hole Playing Handicaps of 5, 10, 12 and 15, respectively. Player A plays at scratch, B receives 5 strokes, C receives 7 strokes and D receives 10 strokes.

SCORE POSTING

NWAGA will post these scores for handicap purposes.

PRIZES
