PLAYER INFORMATION

Thank you for participating in the playing of the 2020 NWAGA Seniors/49ers Eclectic event presented by the Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Association at Wayne Country club. Below is general information to assist with your attendance.

FORMAT

The NWAGA Seniors Championship and the 49ers Eclectic Tournament run concurrently.

The Seniors Championship is a gross 54-hole individual stroke play competition flighted after 36-holes.

The 49ers Eclectic Tournament is an optional 36-hole partner competition conducted during rounds 1 & 2 that takes the best net scores a side has made on each hole over the course of rounds 1 & 2. *For example, on hole one in round one, players A & B, who are partners, both have a score of net 5. During the second round on hole one, player A makes a net 3 and player B makes a net 5. Therefore, their score in the eclectic tournament for hole one would be a net 3.*

PRACTICE ROUNDS

If desired, please contact Wayne Country Club golf shop at (402) 375-1152 to arrange a practice round at an available time. The fee is \$35.00 which includes a cart.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All teams must register Monday prior to their first shotgun start. Registration begins at 9:00 a.m. and will be located outside of the golf shop on day one. **Players cannot arrive more than one hour prior to the shotgun start time.**

GOLF CARTS

The fee for golf carts was included in the entry. Carts will be staged prior outside of the golf shop. The golf shop staff will assist in locating your respective golf cart. Cart signs will indicate which cart is for your team.

BEVERAGE SERVICE

The clubhouse will be available for beverage service each day of the tournament.

MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

Due to COVID-19 concerns, each player will receive a boxed lunch on each day of play. Boxed lunches can be picked up at the clubhouse when making the turn off of #9 or #18.

LODGING

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice facilities will be open to tournament players beginning one hour prior to the shotgun start each day of the tournament. Player's must check-in before using practice facilities. Post-round practice is prohibited.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.

FLIGHTS AND PAIRINGS

In the Seniors Championship, flights of approximately 12 players will be created after 36-holes based on gross score.

For the first round of competition, eclectic sides are paired based on combined Handicap Index with the lowest Team Handicaps beginning play on hole 1. Individual players, not participating in the Eclectic Tournament, will be paired together based on Handicap Index or with an Eclectic side if there are an odd number of sides.

For the second round, eclectic sides will be paired based on first day eclectic scores with the lowest scores beginning play on hole 1. Individual players, not participating in the Eclectic Tournament, will be paired together based on gross score or with an Eclectic side if there are an odd number of sides.

For the final round, players will be paired in groups of four, based on individual gross score through 36-holes. The lowest gross scores will begin play on hole 1.

DIGITAL SCORING

Players will be required to use the USGA TM application (available on iOS and Android app store) which will serve as their Official Tournament Scorecard. Verification of scorecards will be done verbally following the round. Information on using the USGA TM application will be provided in advance with tutorials posted to the NWAGA web site.

HANDICAP ALLOWANCES

Based on August 3 Handicap Revision. An individual's Playing Handicap in the Eclectic tournament is 75% of their Course Handicap. Maximum Individual Handicap Index is 40.4. The Seniors Championship is not handicapped.

SCORE POSTING

NWAGA will post these scores for handicap purposes.

PRIZES

Eclectic: Merchandise: Top third. *Seniors*: Overall Champion: Pewter cup award; Flight Winners: Bag tag award; Merchandise: Top third in each flight; 36-Hole Medalist: Glass bowl.
