PLAYER INFORMATION

Thank you for participating in the playing of the 2021 NWAGA Scramble Tournament presented by the Nebraska Women's Amateur Golf Association at Scotts Bluff Country Club. Below is general information to assist with your attendance.

FORMAT

36-hole Gross four-person modified scramble. In a Scramble, each player plays from the teeing area on each hole, one of the tee shots is selected and all the players play their second shots from that spot. One of the second shots is then selected, and all players play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. This format is modified as follows: The player whose shot is selected does not play the next shot (exception: on the putting green, all team members may putt). Each team member must contribute at least four tee shots.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

If desired, please contact the Scotts Bluff Country Club golf shop at (308) 635-1844 to arrange a practice round at an available time. The fee is \$50.00 which includes a cart.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All teams must register Monday prior to their first shotgun start. Registration begins at 9:00a.m. and will be located outside of the golf shop. Players cannot arrive more than one hour prior to the shotgun start time.

GOLF CARTS

The fee for golf carts was included in the entry. Carts will be staged prior outside of the golf shop. The golf shop staff will assist in locating your respective golf cart. Cart signs will indicate which cart is for your team.

BEVERAGE SERVICE

The clubhouse will be available for beverage service each day of the tournament.

MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

There will be a player hosted luncheon following play on day one. There will be a hosted awards luncheon following the final round on day two.

LODGING

Due to the many lodging opportunities in Scottsbluff/Gering, there is not a reserved room block for this event.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice facilities will be open to tournament players beginning one hour prior to the shotgun start each day of the tournament. Player's must check-in before using practice facilities. Post-round practice is prohibited.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely No Traditional Metal Spikes.

DIGITAL SCORING

Players will be required to use the USGA TM application (available on iOS and Android app store) which will serve as their Official Tournament Scorecard. Verification of scorecards will be done verbally following the round. Information on using the USGA TM application will be provided in advance with tutorials posted to the NWAGA web site.

HANDICAP ALLOWANCES

Based on August 17 Handicap Revision. A team's Playing Handicap is comprised of 25% of the lowest player's Course Handicap, 20% of the second lowest player's Course Handicap, 15% of the third lowest player's Course Handicap and 10% of the highest player's Course Handicap figured to the hundredth decimal point. Maximum Individual Handicap Index is 40.4. Handicap Allowances are only used for Flighting purposes. The event itself is a Gross tournament.

SCORE POSTING

NWAGA will not be posting scores because the Scramble format is an unacceptable score for posting purposes under the World Handicap System.

PRIZES

Gross: Overall Low Gross: Trophy Plates; Gross Flight Winners: Bag tag awards; Merchandise: Top third in each flight.
