The Bellevue University golf coach captures her first player of the year award highlighted by her victory at the Women's Seniors Championship at Holdrege Country Club in August. Liddick fired rounds of 74, 77, and 72 (+7) in route to her second Seniors Championship in as many years. Liddick was also victorious at the Pinehurst tournament at Ashland Golf Club in May where her and partner, Allison Temple, cleared the field by 11 strokes shooting an incredible 126 (-16) over two rounds. Those two wins combined with a second-place finish at the Four-Ball tournament propelled Liddick to the top spot in the NWAGA point standings. Congratulations to Shelly on a great year!



Baete saved her best golf for the back nine, though. She won No. 12 when Thiele's par putt lipped out. Baete then hit it tight on the par-3 13th and dropped the birdie, before a simple up-and-down for birdie on the par-5 14th. The three straight wins gave her a 4-up lead with four holes to play. It was a two-putt par on the long par-3 15th hole that gave Baete a fourth straight win and closed out the match, 5 and 3.

Sydney Taake of Papillion won the Founders' Flight Bracket Final over Ricki Hickstein of Chadron, 3 and 2. The Founders' Flight consisted of players from the Championship Division who did not make the cut for the Championship Bracket.

In the Tournament Division, three other net flight winners were crowned. **Sarah Nordlund** of Elkhorn bested Belinda Rude of Kearney, 2 and 1, to win the Flight 1 Final. **Sally Bryson** of Kearney defeated Chris Seberger of Grand Island by concession to win the Flight 2 Final. **Kathy Garrelts** of Kearney triumphed in Flight 3 over Joyce Gilbert, 4 and 3.


JUNE 26-28, 2019

On a day when only six players in the championship division broke 80, Badura put together a 75 (+3) to secure an eight-stroke win with a 221 (+5) total. It's back-to-back titles for the University of South Dakota golfer, who won her first title last year by two strokes. She's the 11th player to win multiple Nebraska Women's Amateur titles.

In Flight One, **Nancy Pflug** of Omaha was victorious finishing with a 160 (+16) total. **Emalie Wightman** of Omaha was crowned the Flight Two champion with a 188 (+44) total. Rounding out the tournament division, **Karen Jensen** of Ogallala won Flight Three finishing with a 218 (+74) total.





Fremont - Lincoln's **Carrie Bostar** is the Inaugural Nebraska Women's Mid-Amateur Championship, winning by three strokes at Fremont Golf Club on Sunday.

Bostar became the first player to hoist the Laura Saf Memorial Trophy after shooting a final round 79 (+4) to win by three strokes with a 151 (+1) total. Bostar is a former college golfer at Embry -Riddle University in Florida, lives in Lincoln now and was competing in her first NGA championship.

Five-time Nebraska Women's Amateur Champion **Sarah Sasse-Kildow** of Lincoln finished runner-up at 154 (+4) with the low round of the day, a 78 (+3). **Anne Robertson** of Columbus finished third at 158 (+8), while Bellevue's **Kayla Barnes** was fourth at 161 (+11). Two players finished tied for fifth at 162 (+12), including Fremont's **Sophie Ullman** and 18-time NGA champion **Susan Marchese** of Omaha.

Two other flights were settled on Sunday as well, with Elkhorn's Miae Hatfield winning Flight 1 with a 169 (+19) total. Omaha's Elizabeth Wanek won Flight 2 with a 177 (+27) total.

Nebraska started the day a half of a point behind Missouri, after earning four points during the first day of matches. Nebraska won all six singles matches to finish with 10 points, ahead of Missouri in second at seven points. Iowa finished third with four points, and Kansas fourth with three points.


On the first day, Nebraska earned two points in the Foursomes matches. It only took three birdies for Lincoln's Nicole Kolbas and Omaha's Kaitlyn Hanna to take care of business against Missouri winning 5 and 3. Elkhorn's Emily Karmazin and Omaha's Katie Ruge fought for the second point, pulling out a close one against Kansas, 2 and 1.

The afternoon Four-Ball matches also earned Team Nebraska two more points with Hanna and Ruge winning 1 up over lowa, after firing a 33 (-3) on the back nine. Kolbas and Wahoo's Lauren Thiele finished their match much earlier, winning 5 and 4 against Kansas. Kolbas and Thiele won the four-hole stretch from Nos. 11 to 14 to close out their match on the 14th green.

Team Nebraska came out strong for Thursday's singles matches, and did not look back, winning all six. Papillion's

Sydney Taake won her match, 5 and 4, with a chip-in for birdie on the 14th hole to close out the match. Thiele also won 5 and 4 to help propel Team Nebraska to victory. Kolbas closed out her match 3 and 2, while Karmazin and Ruge each finished with 2-and-1 victories. Hanna was the only one to go to the 18th hole, winning her match 1 up.

The team was captained by Lincoln's Stephanie Kolbas, with Snyder's Hannah Hunke serving as her assistant. It's the second time in three years that Nebraska has won the matches.


